# Explain: Mark 2:23 →

Bible study is asking and answering questions about the text. Let's ask some questions.

### Are there any literary/structural observations?

In today's text we are again presented with the Sabbath, and we are introduced to heads of grain, David, Abiathar, and the bread of the Presence. Exodus 25:1, 10, 23, 31, 30, Leviticus 24:5-9, Exodus 20:10; 31:15; 34:21, Deuteronomy 23:24-25, and I Samuel 21:1-6 will be helpful references for today's text. A helpful resource in this space is The Treasury of Scripture Knowledge, by Samuel Bagster.
