GREEK TENSES

- **Present:** right-now continuous
- **Aorist:** occurrence without regard for the amount of time taken to finish the action
- **Imperfect:** action continually or repeatedly happening in past time
- **Perfect:** completed action with the results continuing
- **Future:** anticipated action

GREEK MOODS

- **Indicative:** statement of fact
- **Imperative:** a command
- **Subjunctive:** probability or possibility
- **Optative:** possibility (more remotely possible than subjunctive)
- **Participle:** verbal adjective—can add an –ing)
- **Infinitive:** verbal noun—“to” plus the word
