



TRUTH IS THE GODHEAD

All members of the Trinity are involved. God the Father is Truth. God the Son is Truth: **John 14:6:** Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. God the Holy Spirit is Truth: **John 4:24:** God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.

TRUTH IS THE GOSPEL

John 8:32: And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

1 John 1:8: If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

PASTORS ARE SEEN AS TEACHERS OF THE TRUTH
